






DSM Point-in-Time Totals






Permanent Housing PIT Totals

Unsheltered Zip Codes




These amounts are Unsheltered Last Permanent Housing

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


Housing/Shelter Comparison






Chronic Population PIT Totals






Veteran Population PIT Totals






Youth Population PIT Totals






Point-in-Time Subpopulations






Subpopulation by Type








HIC: Emergency Shelter Beds






HIC: Transitional Housing Beds






HIC: Permanent Housing Beds






Bed Utilization

Results Summary

- Overall reduction in population for the Des Moines/Polk CoC. Reduction due to substantially lower sheltered population (ES and TH)
- Unsheltered population increased from 92 in 2019 to 130 in 2020. This
 increase is approximately what the provider community expected based on
 the last two summer PIT counts. It is likely that 2019 is the outlier of the set.
- Youth subpopulation continues to decline, while Veteran subpopulation stayed approximately the same
