The Alaska HMIS is the database used in the State of Alaska to collect client-level data for housing and services provided to individuals and families at-risk of and experiencing homelessness.

Case Management



Assessing clients' needs for improved client care.

Analysis



Evaluating how organizations can better meet the needs of people with unstable housing.

Housing & Shelter



Connecting clients with housing, services, and shelter.

Funding



Applying for local, state, and federal funding.

Implementing Change



Informing policy change at local, state, and federal levels.
