# What is HIC?

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## Housing Inventory Count (HIC)

- Point-in-time inventory of providers within a Continuum of Care that provide beds and units dedicated to persons who are homeless.
- HIC data is collected for a single night at the end of January.

## The following project types are included:

- Emergency Shelter (ES)
- Transitional Housing (TH)
- Safe Havens (SH)
- Rapid Rehousing (RRH)
- Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH)
- Other Permanent Housing (OPH)

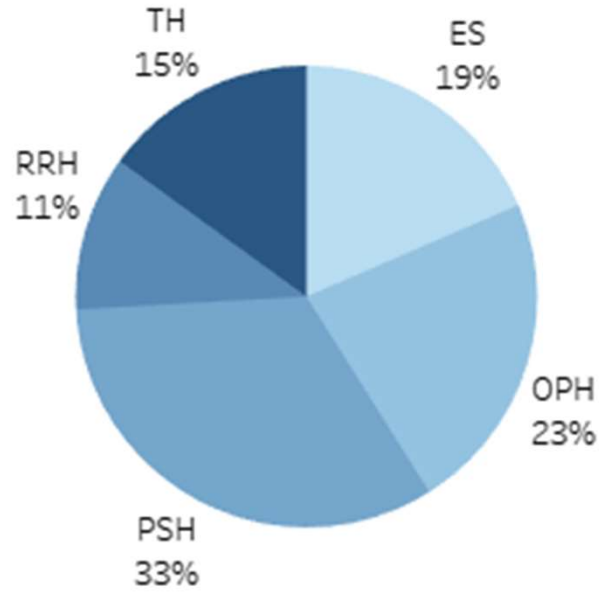

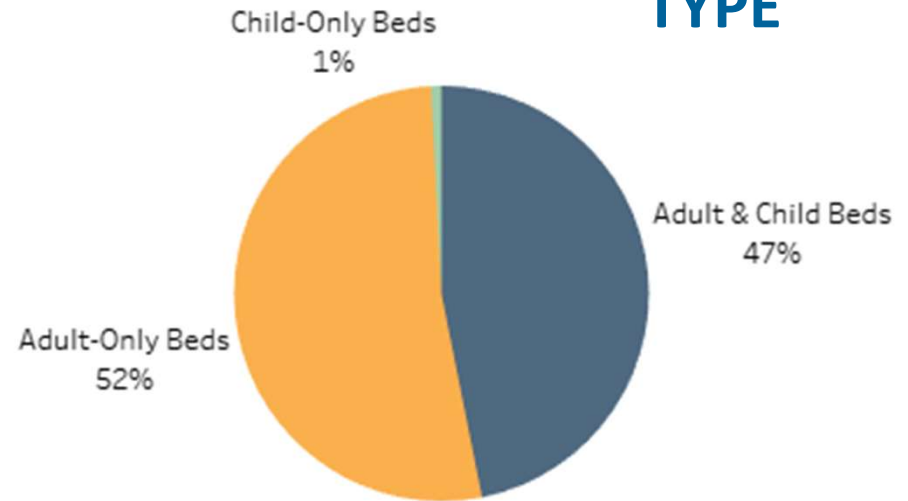

## BED COUNT BY PROJECT TYPE



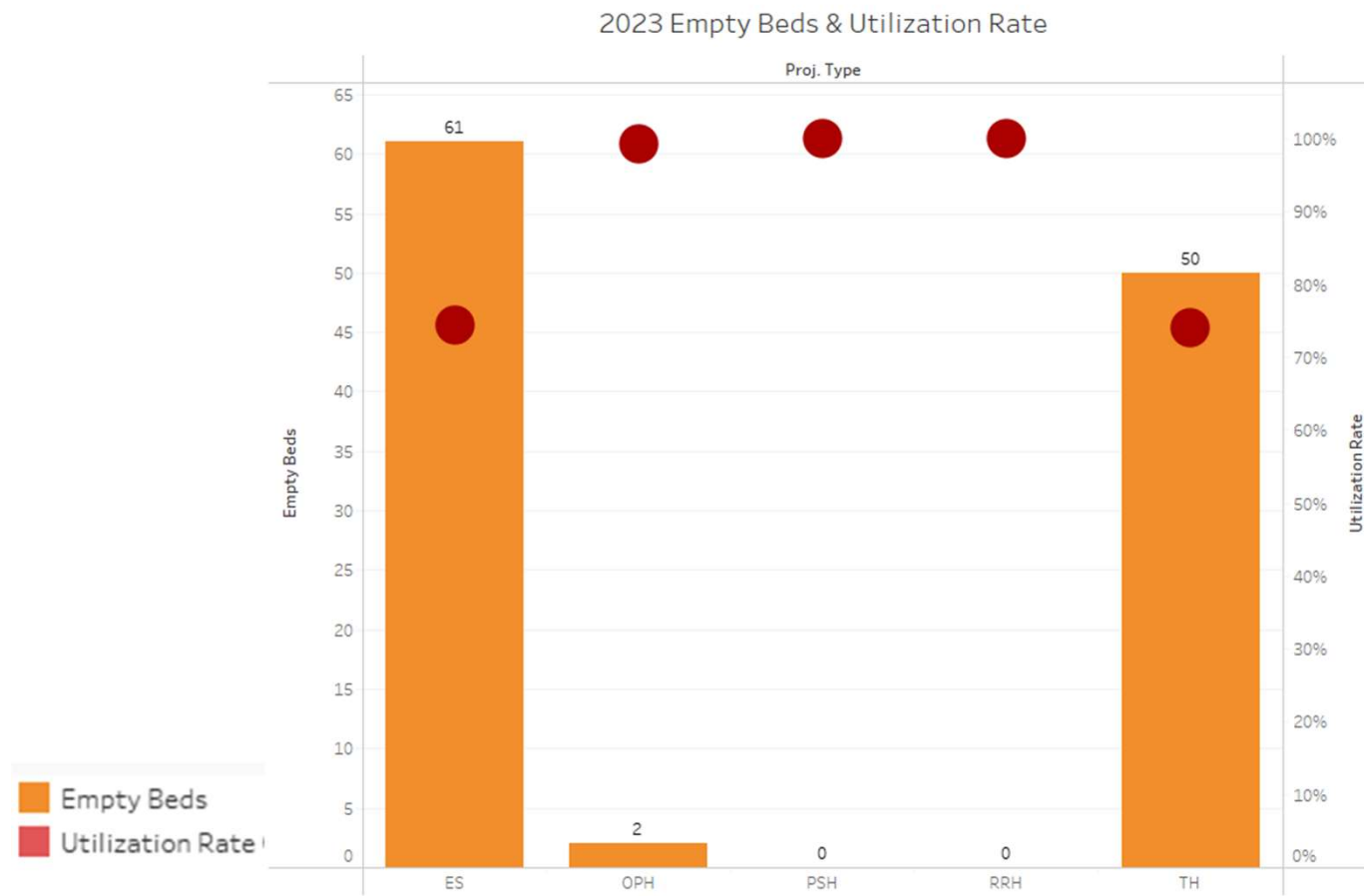
## BED COUNT BY HOUSEHOLD TYPE

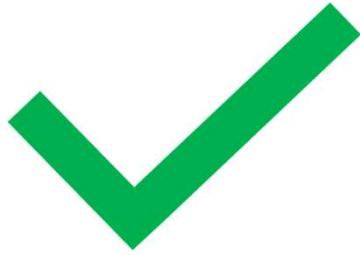




# Increase Utilization

*by 6% to 91%*

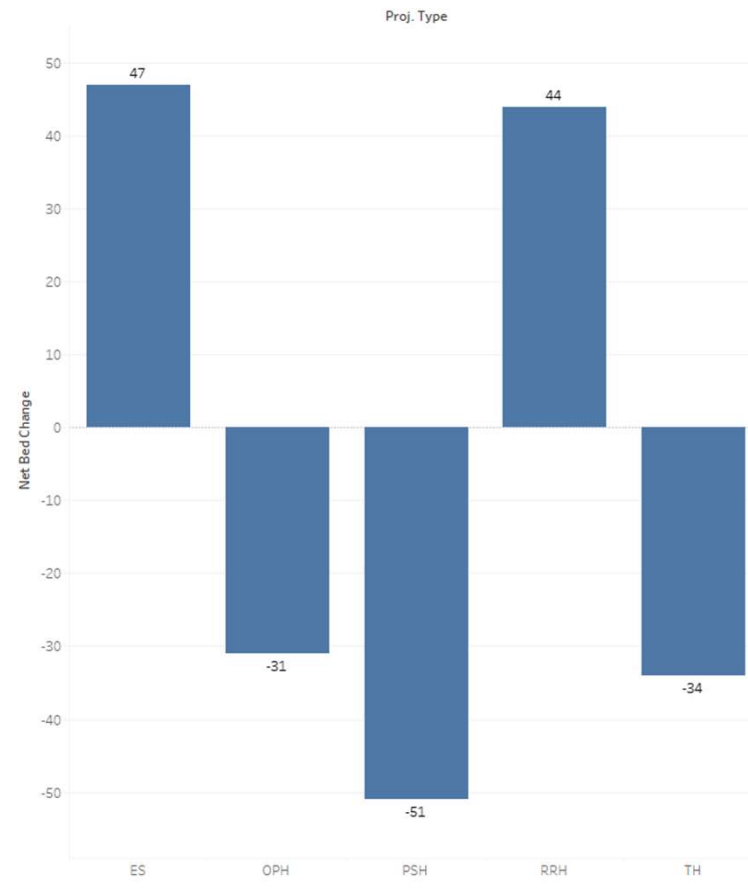




# Increase RRH Beds

2022-2023 Net Bed Change

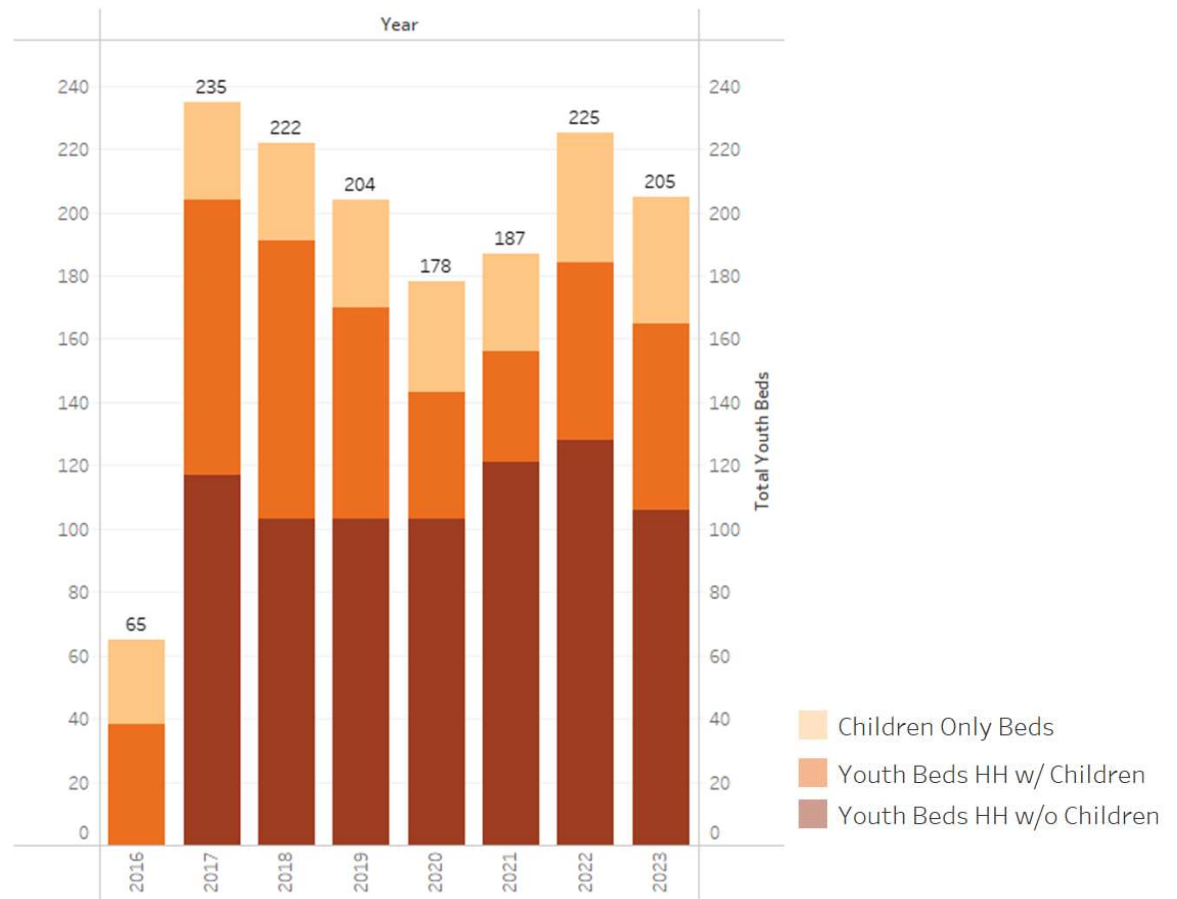


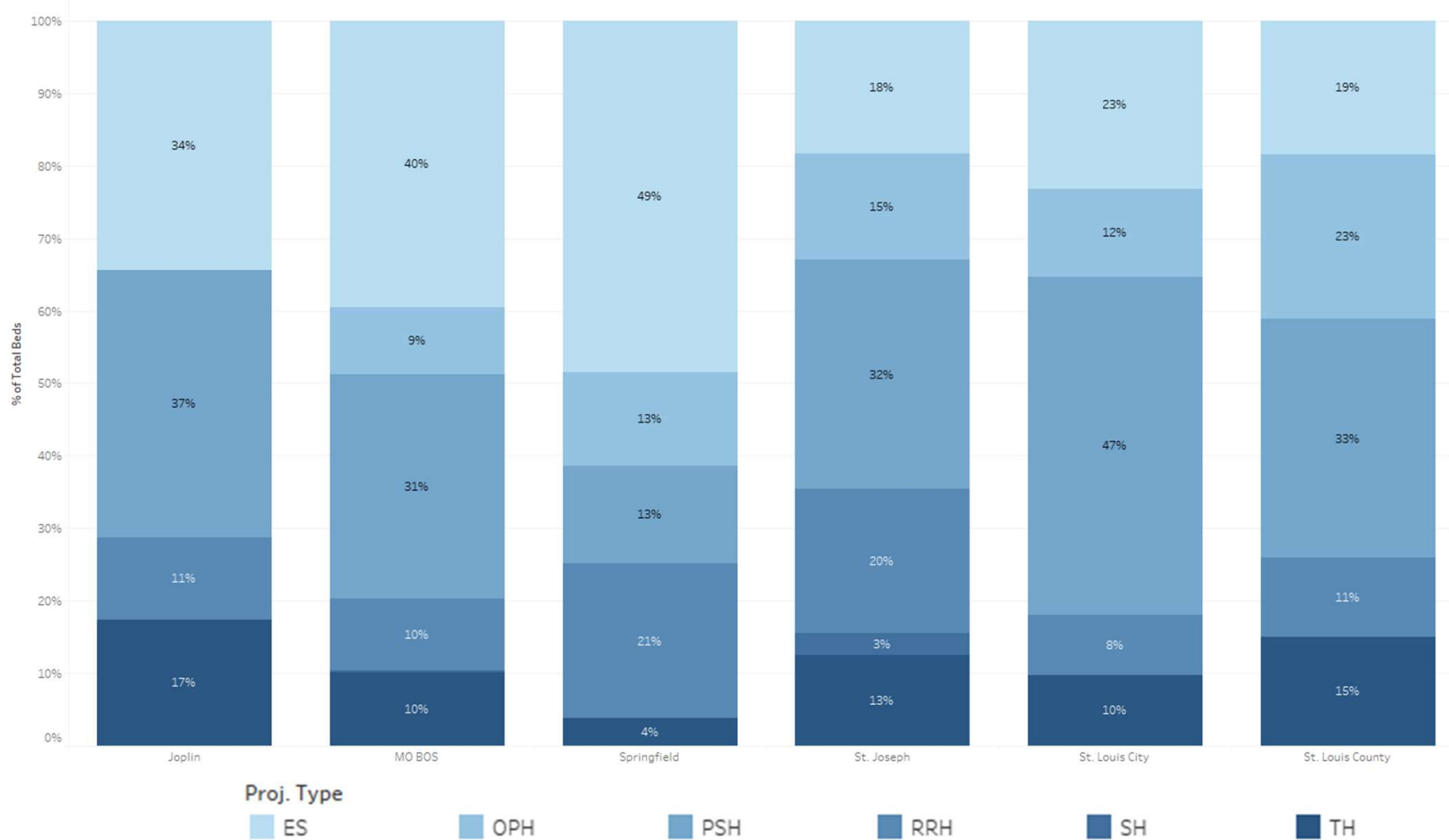

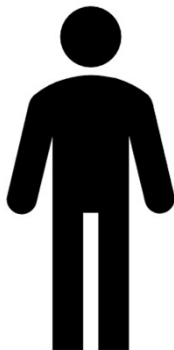
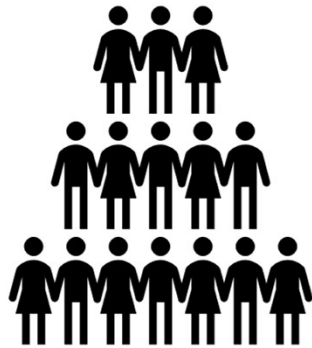
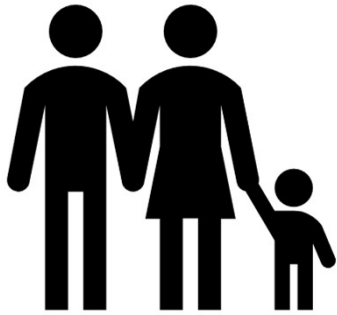

# What is PIT?

## Point In Time (PIT) Count

- Counts and collects demographic information on sheltered and unsheltered persons experiencing homelessness
- Conducted on a single night at the end of January

## Sheltered Count

- Emergency Shelter (ES)
- Safe Havens (SH)
- Transitional Housing (TH)

## Unsheltered (UN) count

- Individuals staying on the streets, encampments, in their car, or other places not intended as housing

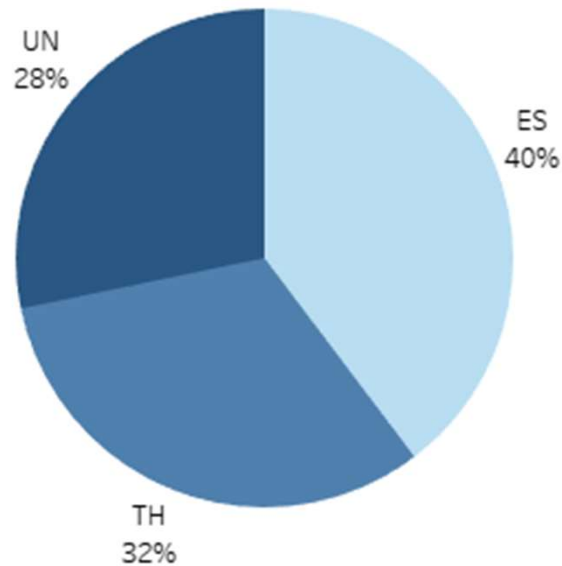

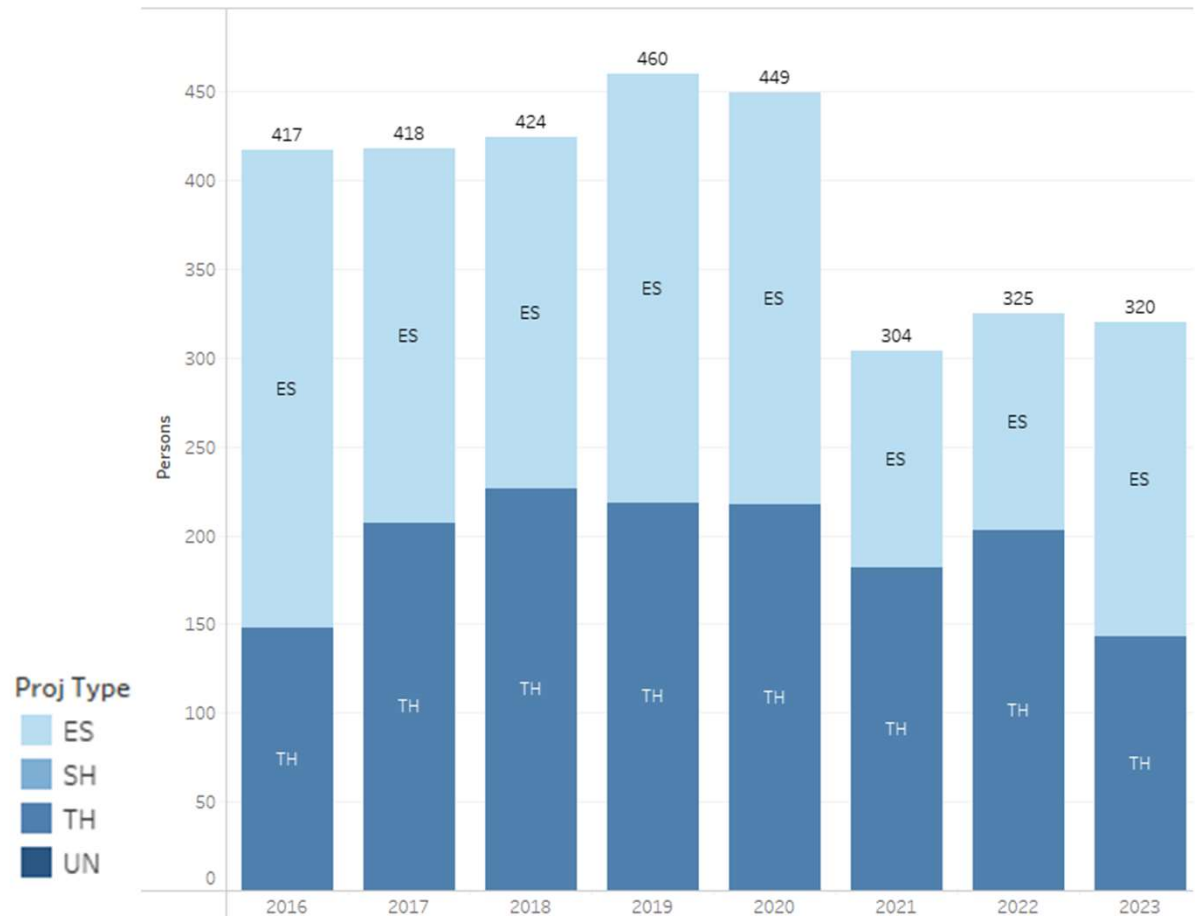

Persons by Year

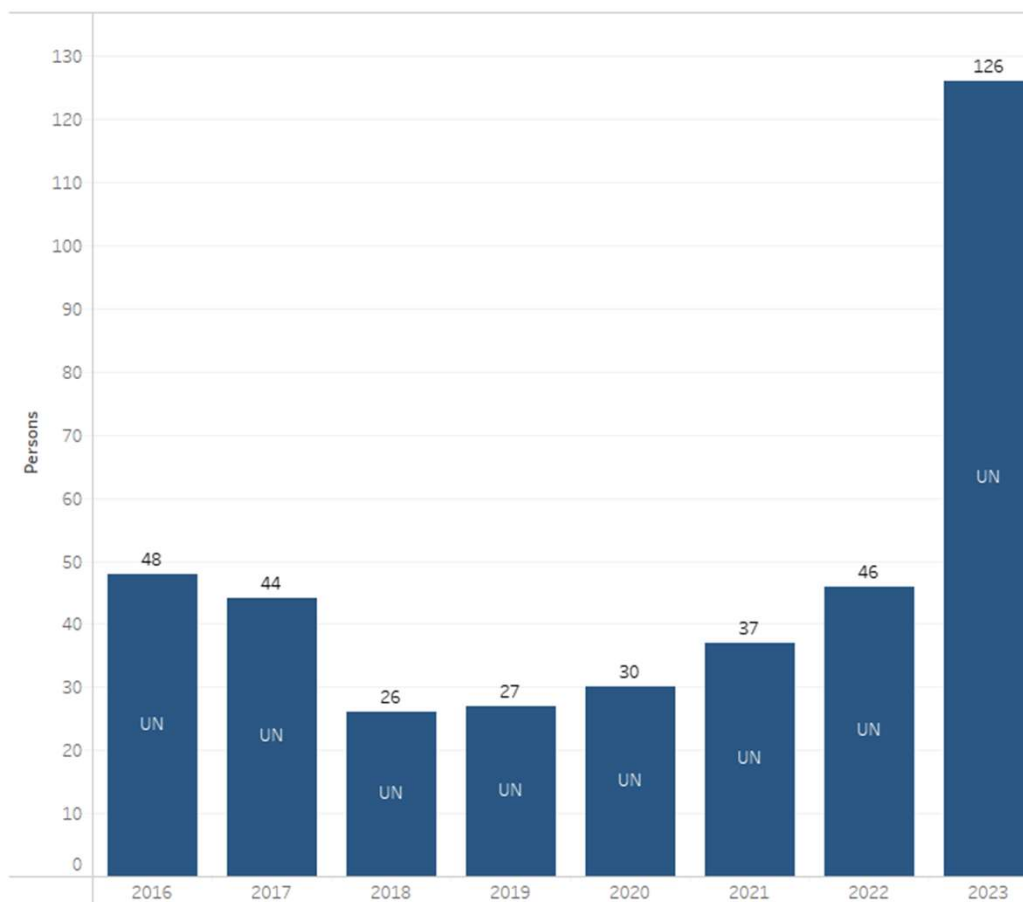




# Reduce Unsheltered Homelessness

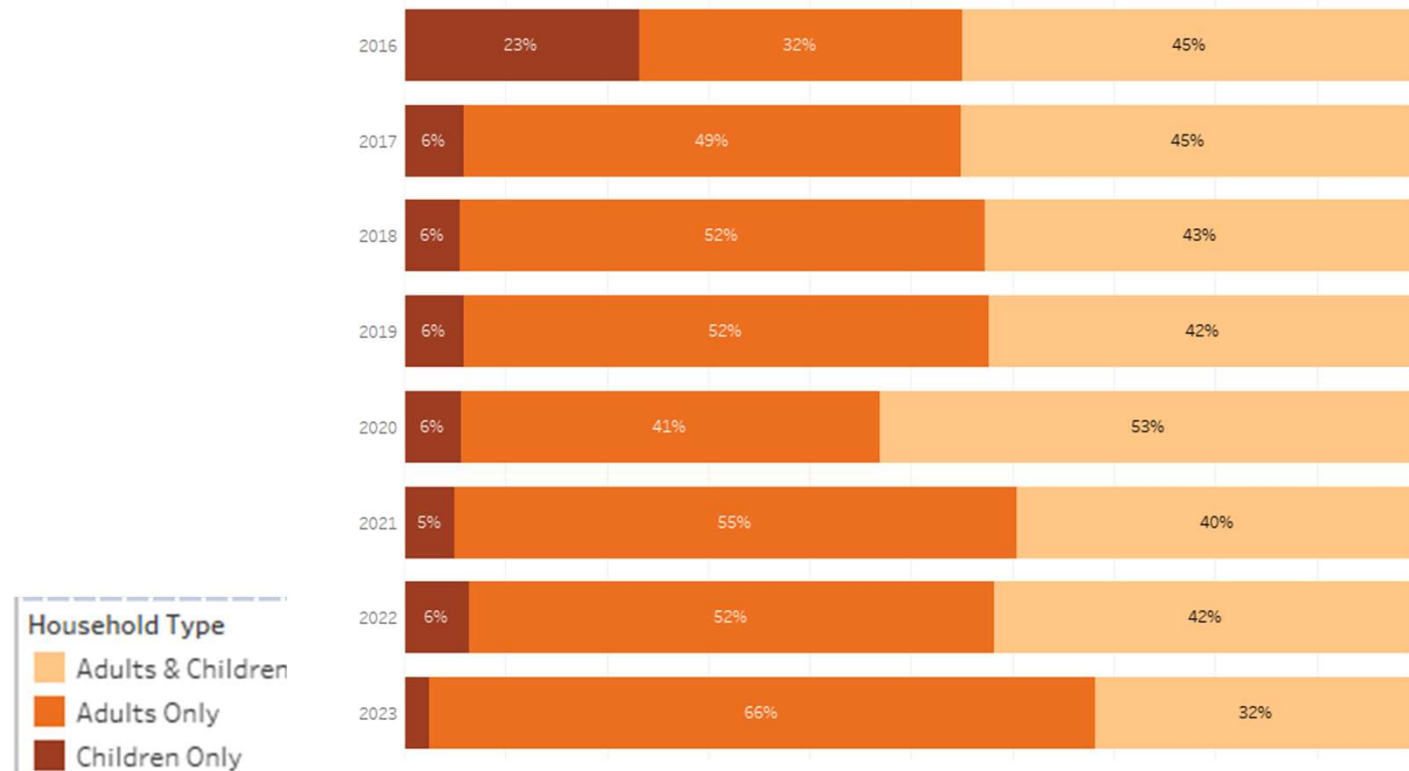




# Reduce Family Homelessness

Persons in Household Type as % of Total Population



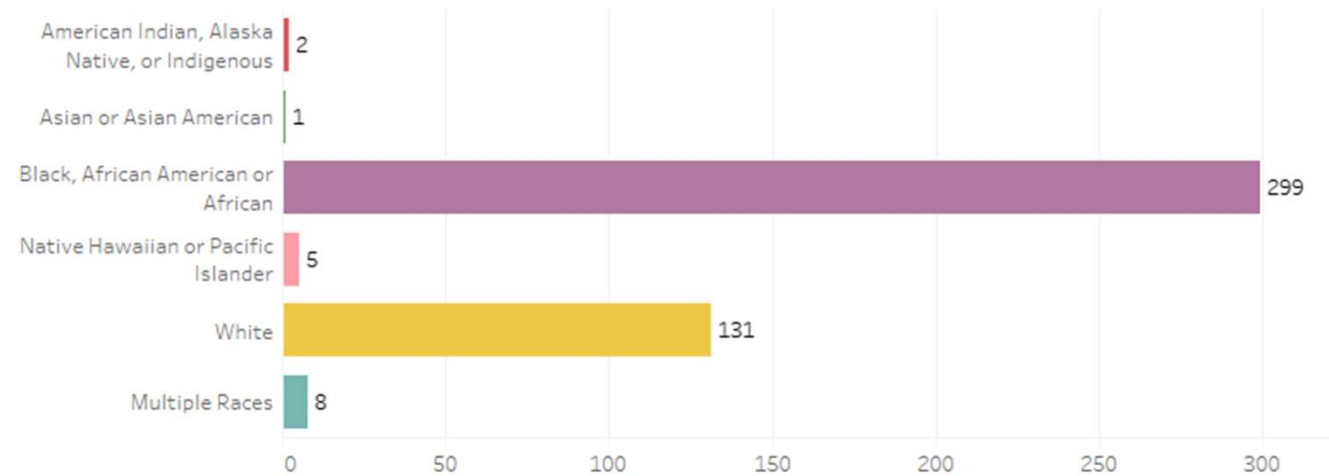


# Reduce Racial Disparity

According to the 2020 Census, Black, African American, or African individuals comprised **24.6%** of the St. Louis County population.

In 2023, Black, African American, or African individuals comprised **67%** of the homeless, **down 8%** from **75%** in 2022.

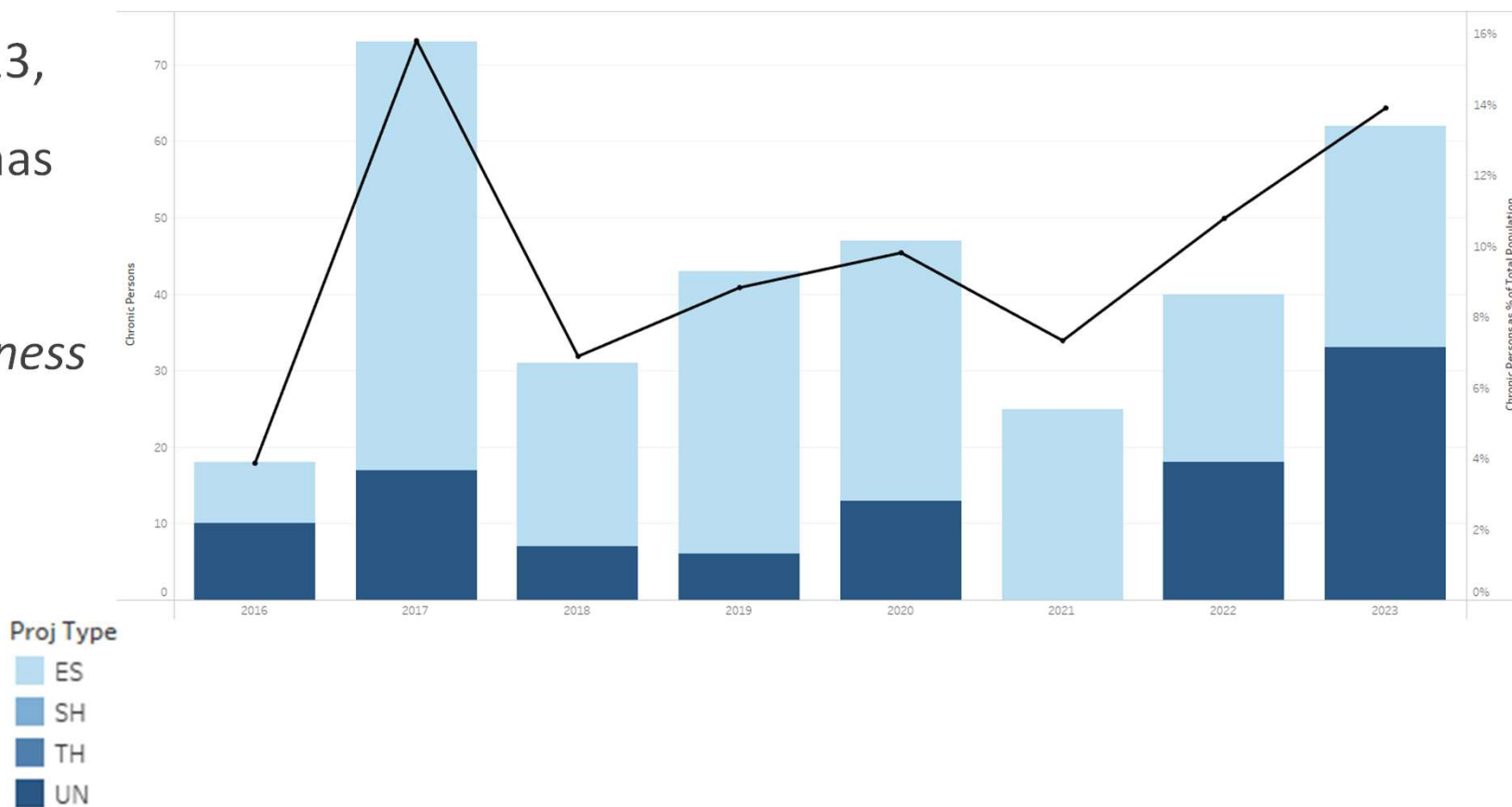

# Reduce Chronic Homelessness

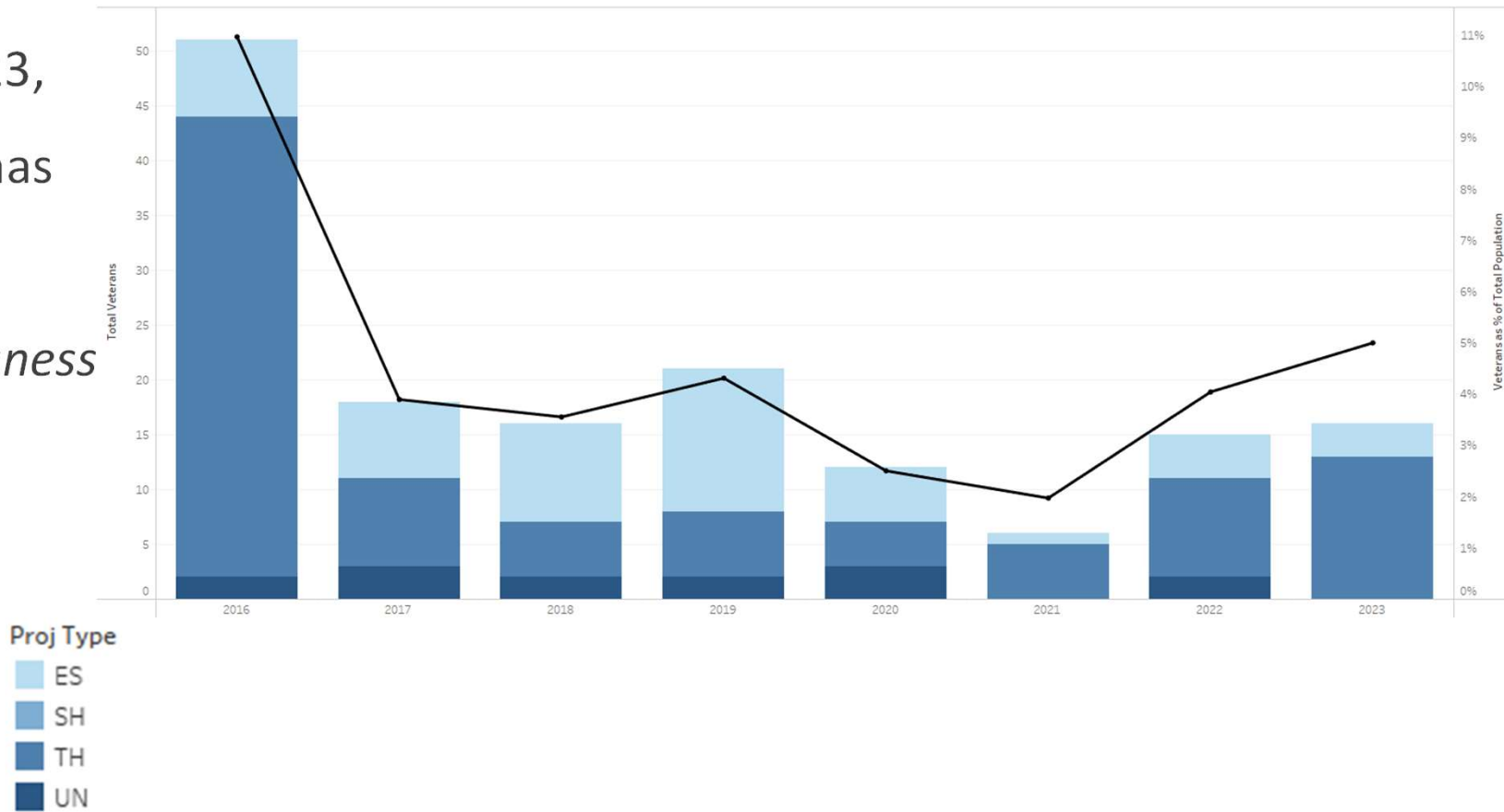
From 2022 to 2023, St. Louis County has **increased** *chronic homelessness* by **55%**





# Reduce Veteran Homelessness

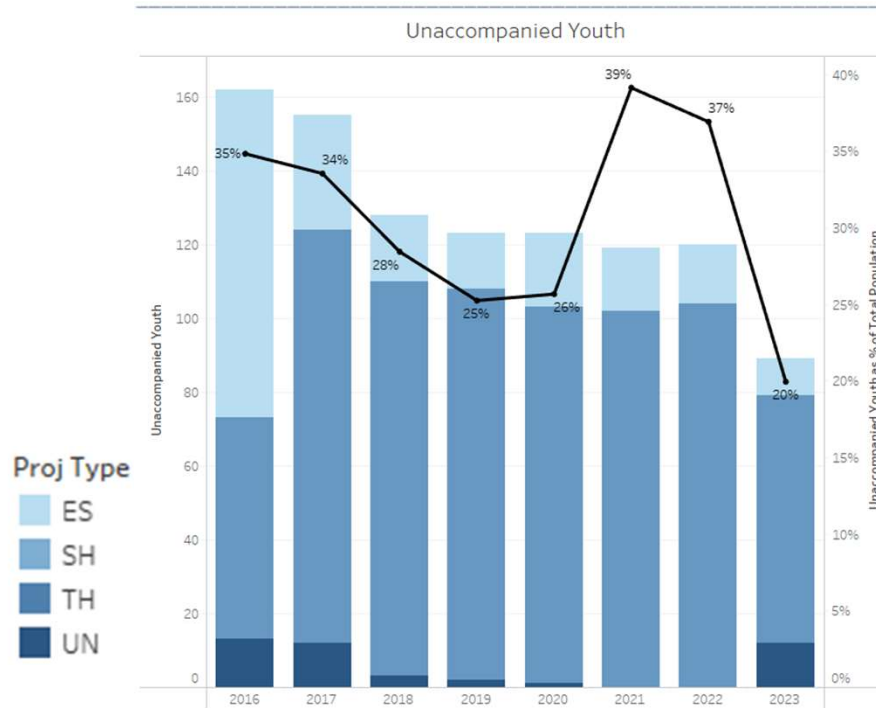
From 2022 to 2023,

by **7%**



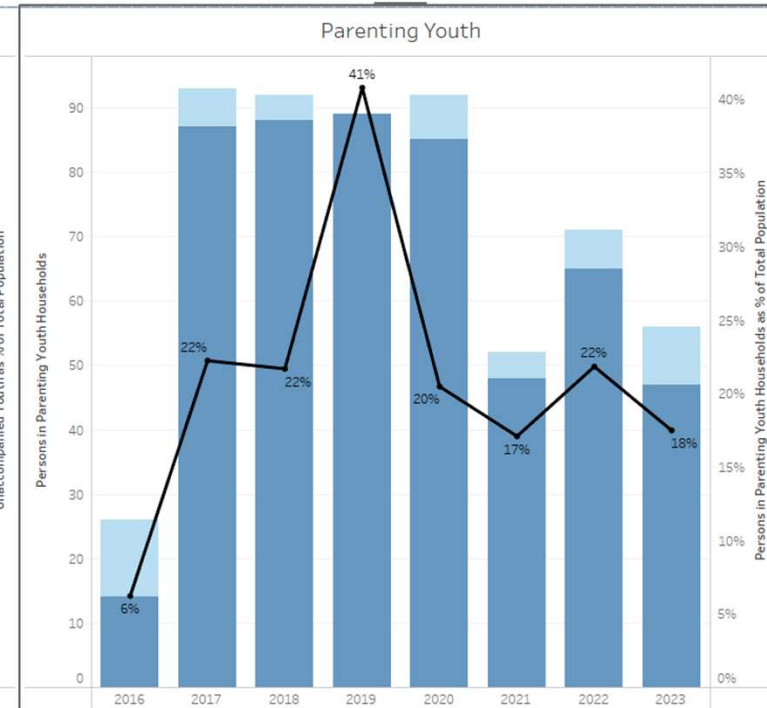

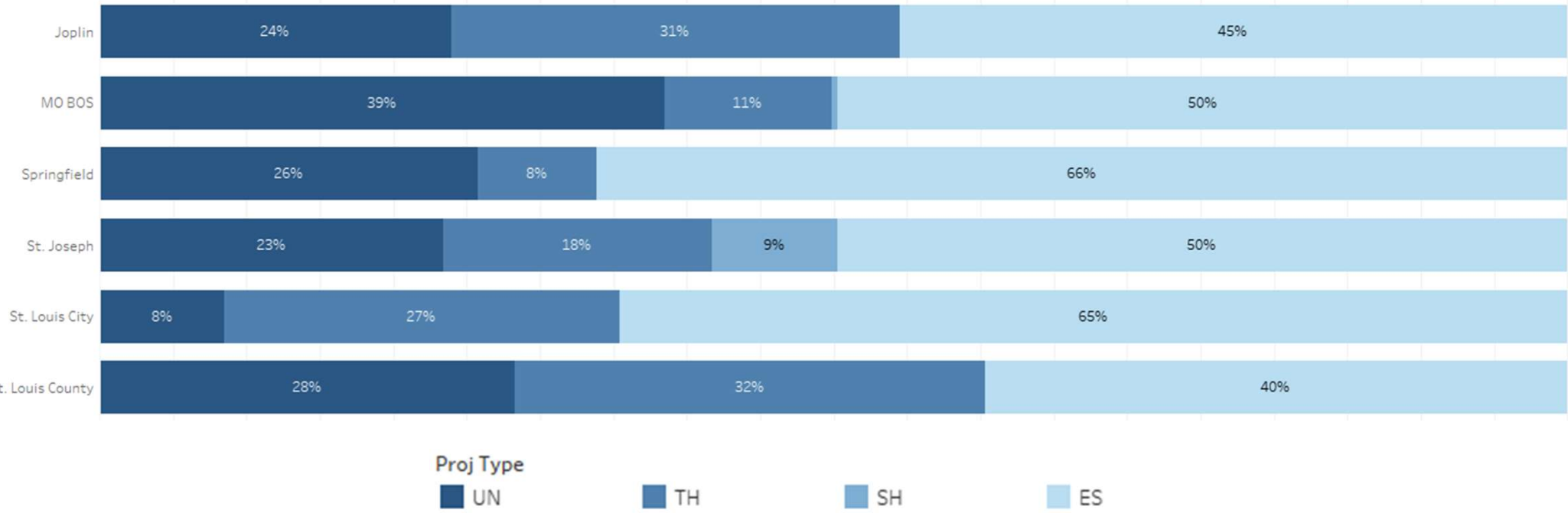
