

What is HIC?

Housing Inventory Count (HIC)

- Point-in-time inventory of providers within a Continuum of Care that provide beds and units dedicated to persons who are homeless.
- HIC data is collected for a single night at the end of January.

The following project types are included:


- Emergency Shelter (ES)
- Transitional Housing (TH)
- Safe Havens (SH)
- Rapid Rehousing (RRH)
- Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH)
- Other Permanent Housing (OPH)







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What is PIT?

Point In Time (PIT) Count

- Counts and collects demographic information on sheltered and unsheltered persons experiencing homelessness
- Conducted on a single night at the end of January

Sheltered Count

- Emergency Shelter (ES)
- Safe Havens (SH)
- Transitional Housing (TH)

Unsheltered (UN) count

• Individuals staying on the streets, encampments, in their car, or other places not intended as housing












Persons in Household Type as % of Total Population






According to the 2020 Census, Black, African American, or African individuals comprised **11.4%** of the Missouri population.

In 2023, Black, African American, or African individuals comprised **36%** of the homeless, **no change** from 2022.











Reduce Veteran Homelessness


In 2023,

The number of people with


Mental Health Disorder


